“ITCHING AND SCRATCHING”

Itching is a skin irritation that creates a desire to scratch. A reaction to poison ivy, poison oak, or poison sumac; prolonged exposure to the sun; insect bites, and such can cause this uneasy, tingling sensation. Most cases of itching are not severe and can be easily treated. But scratching the itching is hardly ever recommended for relieving that aggravating sensation. Yet that’s exactly what most of us do.

Temptation works like that itch. An appeal is made to our worldly nature, and just as itching demands scratching, that temptation seems to demand gratification. Just as poison ivy shouldn’t be scratched, neither should that temptation be yielded to. Religiously speaking, some folks look for preachers who scratch their itching ears; looking to soothe sin’s symptoms with pleasing words. 2 Timothy 4:3-4 says, “For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap for themselves teachers; and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables.”

But what is really needed, like medicine for a bad itch, is the truth that comes from God’s Word. Are your ears itching? Go to God’s word and get them healed instead of just scratched.
