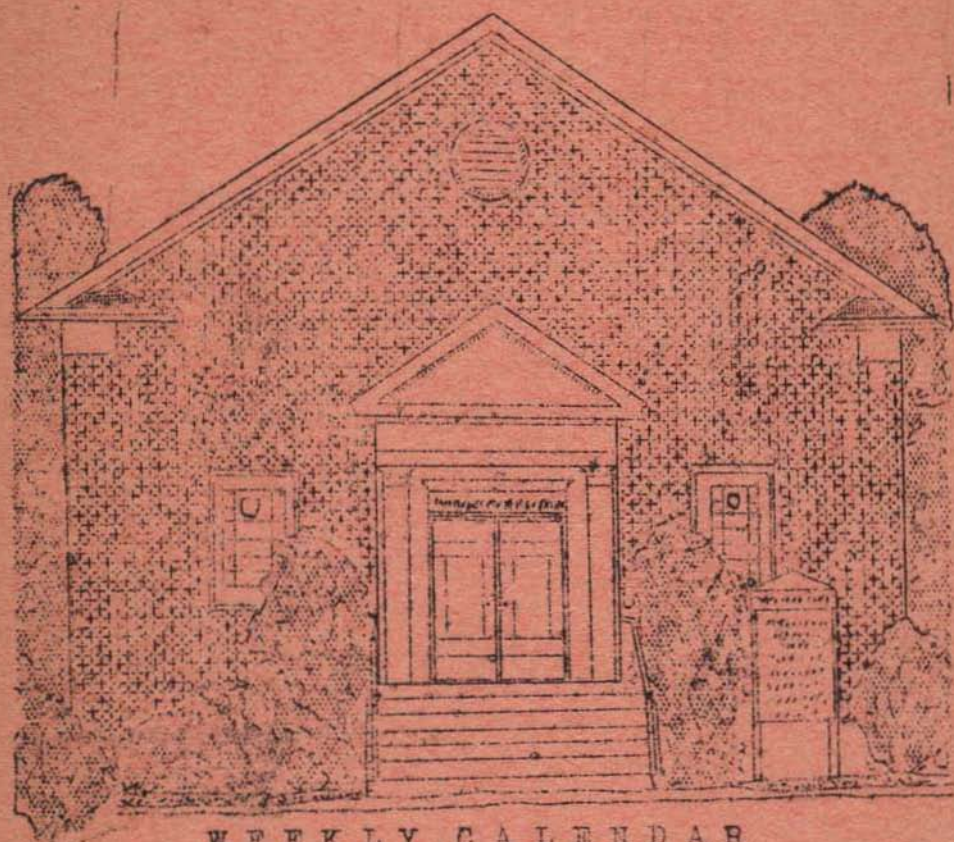

ETERNAL SALVATION

Eternal life is the desire of every people on the earth. Eternal life is the HOPE of every faithful Christian. Jesus said, "Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. John 14: 1-3. To be able to inhabit one of the mansions in his Father's house should be the goal of every child of God.

Jesus Christ is the author of eternal salvation. "Though he were a Son, yet learned he obedience by the things which he suffered; and being made perfect, he became the author of eternal salvation unto all them that obey him;" Hebrews 5:8-9. We must render obedience to every command of the Lord Jesus Christ, before we can inhabit a mansion in the Father's house. "Blessed are they that do his commandments, that they may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city." Rev. 22:14.

To the alien sinner his commands are: (1) faith, (2) repentance, (3) confession, (4) baptism for the remission of sins. Those who obey these commands from the heart are Christians, or children of God. They are to worship God in spirit and in truth, grow in grace and knowledge of the Lord. They are to produce the fruits of the Spirit. Galatians 5:22-23.

When in the course of this life they yield to temptation and sin, they are commanded to: (1)repent of their sins,(2)confess their sin,(3)pray for forgiveness.

When this life is over the body will return to the dust from whence it came, and the spirit to God who gave it. Eccl.12:7. At the Lord's return "we will all have to appear at the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad." 2 Cor. 5:10. Those who have remained faithful will hear, "Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world:" Matt. 25:34. Those who refuse to obey Christ will hear, "Depart from me ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels:" Matt. 25:41. Dear reader in which of these groups will you be found? Why not obey and be saved. The glories of this future world are beyond our imagination. John describes it thus: "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth; for the first heaven and the first earth were passed away; and there was no more sea. And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband. And I heard a great voice out of heaven saying, Behold, the tabernacle of God is with men, and he will dwell with them, and they shall be his people, and God himself shall be with them, and be their God. And God shall wipe away all tears from their eyes; and there shall be no more death, neither sorrow, nor crying, neither shall there be any more pain; for the former things are passed away. Rev. 21:1-4.
