## REACHING THE LOST

One of your children's friends asks you, "Where you go to church" and you respond with, "the church of Christ," and he replies, "What kind of church is that?" What do you say next?

You may have already been in that situation with co-workers or relatives and friends. It was probably an awkward situation if you were not prepared with an answer.

## **ELDERS CORNER:**

## ARE YOU A FOLLOWER OF JESUS?

"Then Jesus said to them, 'Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men" [Mark 1:17 (NKJV)]. Granted, Jesus was speaking to James and John who later became two of his apostles. However, Jesus also told his apostles in Matthew 28:19-20 (NKJV): "Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, *even* to the end of the age." From these verses, we understand that we are to observe the things that Jesus commanded his apostles.

Realizing that Jesus wants all of his followers to become fishers of men, every Christian should be willing to do his or her part to make Jesus' promise in Mark 1:17 a reality. You may be thinking to yourself: "I'm not able to teach others." Assuming this is true, should you not be willing to study and prepare yourself to become a fisher of men? Jesus did not desire to sacrifice himself on the cross, but he was willing to do what was necessary to provide salvation for mankind. Even so, his sacrifice will not benefit those who do not obey the gospel of Christ because they have not been taught.

Until you've put forth the effort to develop your talents and put them to use, there is no way of knowing what you will be able to accomplish with God's help. Paul will be teaching The Fishers of Men training course at Warners Chapel on Monday night from 7:00-8:30 pm, beginning August 4, 2008. If you haven't taken advantage of previous training courses, this is your opportunity to make Jesus' promise a reality for you personally. The Fishers of Men material for this course will be purchased from the church treasury for each new student. Anyone who has taken the course previously will already have the material should you want to audit the course.

Beginning August 6, 2008, a Personal Evangelism course will be taught to NCSBS students on Wednesday from 9:00 am -12:00 pm, which will include Fishers of Men. The elders encourage everyone to take advantage of these opportunities, because they are two of the ways that Jesus accomplishes his promise to make his followers become fishers of men. Jesus has done his part. We are confident that Paul will do his. As a follower of Christ, you can make his promise a reality if you keep in mind Philippians 4:13 (NKJV): "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me."
