MEMORIAL DAY

The following facts are from the Wikipedia website:

"Many people observe this holiday by visiting cemeteries and memorials. A national moment of remembrance takes place at 3 p.m. local time. Another tradition is to fly the flag of the United States at half-staff from dawn until noon local time. Volunteers often place American flags on each grave site at National Cemeteries.

Members of the Veterans of Foreign Wars take donations for poppies in the days leading up to Memorial Day; the poppy's significance to Memorial Day is the result of the John McCrae poem "In Flanders Fields."

In addition to remembrance, Memorial Day is also used as a time for picnics, barbecues, family gatherings, and sporting events. One of the longest-standing traditions is the running of the Indianapolis 500, an auto race which has been held in conjunction with Memorial Day since 1911. The Coca-Cola 600 has been held later the same day since 1961.

The National Memorial Day Concert takes place on the west lawn of the United States Capitol. The concert is broadcast on PBS and NPR. Music is performed, and respect is paid to the men and women who gave their lives for their country.

Some Americans view Memorial Day as the unofficial beginning of summer and Labor Day as the unofficial end of the season."

Family gatherings, picnics, etc. have long been a tradition of the celebration of Memorial Day. When I was young my parents called it "Decoration Day," because we always made a trip to the cemetery to decorate the graves of our relatives.

Today is our Friends and Family Day and we hope this will help us to be closer together.

NICARAGUA HERE WE COME

It's less than two weeks until ten Christians from Warners Chapel will be leaving for Nicaragua on a medical/evangelism trip with fifty or sixty other Christians from all over the southeastern United States. The Warners Chapel participants will be flying out of Greensboro at 7:30 a.m. Friday, June 11, and returning June 19. Except for the final stages of packing, most of the arrangements have already been made. The participants will be meeting Sunday night [May 30th] after the evening worship service in an effort to make sure everything has been taken care of.

The estimated expense for the trip is approximately \$1500 per person not counting the cost of passports and vaccines. Each participant contributed \$200.00 as a commitment fee at the time they submitted their application. \$750.00 per person will be funded from the church treasury. The remaining \$550.00 will be the responsibility of each participant unless other individuals contribute toward the remaining expense. Also, we normally take money for purchasing food, medicine, or Bibles while in Nicaragua. For those of you who can't go to Nicaragua, this is an opportunity for you to participate in addition to your regular contribution. If you desire to contribute, write your check to Warners Chapel and put it in the Nicaragua envelops you'll find on the credenza if the foyer.

Each participant will check two bags, one for personal belongings and one for benevolent items. Our ladies have made approximately 350 dresses and others have contributed clothing, flip-flops, caps, and toys. The flight will take approximately 3½ hours. Arriving in Nicaragua just before noon, the participants will begin the process of acclimating themselves to the hot, humid climate. Before returning home, the group will have an opportunity to affect the lives of several thousand people both physically and spiritually. It's no picnic, but rewarding just the same. Pray for the campaign and do whatever else you can to make it a success. Your efforts will be rewarding to you as well.
