God's Remedy for Hydrophobia (Part 3)

God made a promise to Abraham that his descendants would be delivered from bondage (cf. Genesis 15:13-14). Joseph prophesied of the time when God would deliver Israel from Egyptian bondage (Gen. 50:25; Heb. 11:22). In the opening chapters of Exodus, we read of that deliverance. God called Moses to be His spokesman and the leader of the Israelites (Ex. 3 & 4). In spite of the miracles God did by Moses, the king would not allow Israel to depart. Until finally, when the firstborn of all Egyptians died, permission was granted for them to leave. But the king changed his mind, gathered his army, and began pursuit. Israel was encamped at the Red Sea. What a predicament they felt themselves in: the sea in front, the Egyptian army behind.

I am pretty sure there must have been some hydrophobias among the Israelites, but God had planned all this. Now Moses stretches his rod over the sea, it parts, and the people all pass through as on dry land. When the Egyptians tried to do the same, the walls of water came back together and the army perished (Ex. 14). How was Israel delivered? Let God answer in Paul's writing of 1 Cor. 10:1-2, "Our fathers were under the cloud, and all passed through the sea; and were all baptized unto Moses in the cloud and in the sea." The waters that destroyed the Egyptian army made Israel a free people.
