WHO IS IN CONTROL?

Is this world spinning madly out of control? Is there any purpose in all that is happening? These are the kinds of questions that have been asked by many for thousands of years. Every century has its wars and troubled times. This Twenty-First Century is no different. There is no panic, especially when we find Biblical answers to the questions proposed above.

Is this world spinning madly out of control? The answer is no. Is there any purpose in all that is happening? The answer to that question is yes. God is in control and He has a purpose in all that He does. The book of Daniel makes these facts very clear. In reading the visions of Nebuchadnezzar and Daniel we see very clearly that God works in the kingdom of men to accomplish His will. God knows the futures of kingdoms and nations. God controls the futures of kingdoms and nations. God has a purpose in all that He does.

These facts are brought out clearly and specifically in Daniel, chapter four. God humbled King Nebuchadnezzar. King Nebuchadnezzar was the most powerful world ruler of his day. His power puffed him up and he became very arrogant. God humbled him by removing him from the throne and by causing him to live like a beast for a time. Following his humbling, Nebuchadnezzar spoke of the lessons he learned. Nebuchadnezzar learned that God's "dominion is from generation to generation" (Daniel 4:3). God is an eternal being. He created this world and He will be in control of it until He puts an end to this world. That includes our generation. That includes the Twenty-First Century. Nebuchadnezzar also learned "That the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, gives it to whomever He will, and

The prophet Habakkuk understood that God was in control of the nations. He asked God how long it would be before Israel was punished for her sin (Habakkuk 1:2-4). God told him the time was coming when the Chaldeans (Babylonians) would come and punish Israel (Habakkuk 1:5-11). The prophet trembled at the thought of the Chaldeans coming through his land destroying his people (Habakkuk 3:16). However, Habakkuk made up his mind to trust in God (Habakkuk 3:17-19). God still rules over nations today, just as He did in Habakkuk's day. Just as Habakkuk put his trust in God during difficult times, so should we. God is in control.

The world is not spinning out of control. God is working through the choices of men and the nations of men to accomplish His will. In His infinite wisdom, He can see where all of this is going and how it will turn out. We need have no worries. God will take care of it all.
