WHY PREACH THE GOSPEL?

There are some who conclude that if one is born in a foreign land, in a remote village, and never comes in contact with Holy Scripture, that God will somehow forgive him and allow him to enter Heaven. Although it seems reasonable to conclude this, the conclusion is false. The New Testament teaches that one may enter Heaven by being obedient to the commands of God. "Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven." (Matthew 7:21). It is only through following Jesus that we can hope to obtain Heaven as our reward. "My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me: And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand." (John 10:27-29). Let us reduce this to a logical argument (Modus Ponens):

- 1. If it is the case that the Bible (specifically the N.T.) teaches that no man can be saved apart from the Gospel, then all men are lost apart from the saving power of the Gospel.
- 2. It is the case that the Bible (specifically the N.T.) teaches that no man can be saved apart from the Gospel.
- 3. Therefore all men are lost apart from the saving power of the Gospel.

To answer the title question we must conclude from the logical argument that all men are lost apart from the saving power of the Gospel. That being the case, we should be taking the Gospel into all the world so that the world might come to know Jesus as Savior. This is the only way they will reach Heaven.

What forces lie in importunate prayer! What mighty results are gained by it in one night's struggle in praying! God is affected and changed in attitude and men are transformed in character and destiny. Satan dreads nothing but prayer.
