The story is told of a burial detail at Bataan, during World War Two, that found a poem on the body of a nineteen year old from Indiana who lost his life in a bloody battle. "And if our lines should sag and break because of things you failed to make, that extra tank, that ship, that plane for which we waited all in vain: will you then come to take the blame? For we, not you, must pay the cost, for battles you, not we have lost." This was an indictment of industrial absenteeism, and the young man was right because Bataan and many lives were lost for failure on the **home** front.

Will your children die because you failed them on the home front? Teaching and being an example must accompany each other, and if you fail to do one or the other, the end result will not be as happy as it would have been with both.

Don't let your children go into spiritual warfare without the right support from home.
