## **THE LORD’S SUPPER**

Before His death, Jesus Christ gave instructions to His disciples concerning the observance of the Lord’s Supper (Matthew 26:26-28; Mark 14:22-25; Luke 22:14-23). In keeping with these instructions the early church regularly took part in this memorial when they assembled together (1 Corinthians 11:23-26).

The word “church” translates a word that means “called out to an assembly.” Christians are those that are in the church and therefore are called out from the world to assemble. The assembly of Christians for the purpose of worship is a requirement from God (Hebrews 10:25). Acts 20:7 along with 1 Corinthians 16:1-2 shows us the day upon which the Christians regularly assembled was the first day of the week, or literally, “the first after the Sabbath.” The first day of the week had become significant with the resurrection of Jesus Christ having occurred on that day (John 20).

When Christians assembled every first day of the week and partake of the Lord’s Supper they are engaging in an act of worship that is significant for a number of reasons. All acts of worship are significant when prescribed by God because He has the authority to tell us how to worship and because worship is directed toward Him. Additionally, the partaking of the Lord’s Supper every Sunday is important of what it memorializes and what it shows. It shows the Lord’s death, one of, if not the most important events in the entire history of man’s existence.

God created this earth through Jesus Christ (John 1:1-3; Colossians 1:14-18). Though created by God, and in the image of God, man chose to rebel against God (Genesis 3). The introduction of sin into this world put man in need of salvation. The character of God is perfect in justice, holiness, purity, power, and inherent authority over His creation. To sin against God is a matter far more serious than we normally think. Sin as rebellion against God is deserving of the wrath of God. God is the self-existent Creator who has naturally authority over man. Every time man sins he rejects that authority. As the authority, God naturally responds with wrath, (Romans 1:18). Not only is sin deserving of wrath, but it is also deserving of death (Romans 6:23). We deserve wrath and death for our sins but Jesus Christ came and took the wrath and death for us in the cross (Romans 5:6-11). Now, because of what Jesus has done, we can have eternal life instead of the wages we deserve (Romans 6:23). This act of God's gracious love should produce rejoicing within us.

Every time we partake of the Lord's Supper we are remembering the event that made it possible for each of us to have eternal life instead of the death we deserve. Peace and joy should characterize the observance. But, sorrow for sin should also be considered. It was our sin that sent the Lord to the cross. Man rebelled against his Creator and then man killed his Creator. The Creator willingly died for those who sinned against Him and for those who hated Him. It was a gruesome, and violent death for the perfectly innocent Son of God who endured as much for our salvation. When we consider this is what we are remembering when we partake of the Lord's Supper we should never consider it an insignificant event. In fact, the blessing and privilege of partaking of the Lord's Supper every Sunday should be something we look forward to with great anticipation and joy.
