Knute [proper pronunciation *Ka-noote Rock-nuh*, common pronunciation *Noot Rock-nee*] Rockne was the coach for the Notre Dame football team during the 1920's. He was a showman and brought exciting enthusiasm to the teams he coached. One of the speeches that he gave was a re-creation of a pre-game speech he could have given many times. The following is an excerpt from that time.

We're going inside of 'em, we're going outside of 'em -- inside of 'em! outside of 'em! - and when we get them on the run once, we're going to keep 'em on the run... But don't forget, men -- we're gonna get 'em on the run, we're gonna go, go, go, go! -- and we aren't going to stop until we go over that goal line!

The elders at Warners Chapel believe it is important to periodically visit and encourage the works we support with your contributions. On November 4th Steve Martin will leave for Zambia to visit the work of the "Zambia School of Biblical Studies".

While there for 16 days he plans to: (1) Speak to the school students about the need to develop leadership in each congregation of the Lord's church. (2) Attend the graduation ceremony of the present class of 20 students on November 15th. (3) Visit some of the areas in the bush where irrigation drip kits are being used. Warners sent 200 drip kits to Zambia in June of this year to be used by preachers to raise food for their families during the dry season. (4) To visit some of the congregations within traveling distance of the school to encourage them.

While there we will have many benevolence and evangelism opportunities. There is a need to reproduce some good teaching material for use by the brethren there. The students and instructors do evangelism campaigns on the weekend when money is available for gasoline (\$6.00 per gallon). There is no money in the school operating budget for this. Several congregations have been started from these continuing efforts. If you would like to give money to help with benevolence and evangelism in this area of Zambia, please make your check to Warners Chapel and put it an envelope and write Zambia on the envelope.
