IDENTIFYING JESUS

The New Testament makes bold claims about Jesus. Peter's confession that Jesus was the Christ the son of the living God is a good example of such. John's Gospel begins with the information that Jesus pre-existed before the beginning of time (John 1:1-14). This being said it appears that there are only two alternatives before us:

1. Jesus is everything that the New Testament writers have said that he is.
2. Or the New Testament is a carefully orchestrated fraud!
We need to consider the implications of the second statement above. What if the statements concerning Jesus in the New Testament are false?

First, the authors suffered extreme hardship for declaring what they knew was a lie!

Second, the martyrs who died in the name of Jesus, died knowing it was a lie!

Third, they went against everything they themselves and Jesus taught! Somehow these liars, frauds and deceivers came up with a book containing the world's highest standard of morality and ethics.

I am convinced that those will not receive the New Testament as valid, inspired and authoritative have never read it, nor have they considered the implications of regarding it as a mixture of fact and fiction.

You must consider these facts and make up your mind about the identity of Jesus. Is he liar or Lord?
