BIBLICAL WARNINGS CONCERNING FALSE PROPHETS

Matthew 7:13-29 is an important record of the powerful and authoritative words of Jesus Christ concerning false prophets and it is in this context Jesus tells us most people will be lost. False teaching is one of the reasons so many will choose the broad path to destruction as opposed to the narrow path to life. Those described by Jesus use deceptive means to lead souls astray. They look good, but are not what they appear to be. They seem to be gentle, and appear to be one of the flock, but when the opportunity arises their true nature will make itself known as they begin to devour the flock in the manner of ravenous wolves. Christians can be torn apart spiritually by false prophets who deceive them and take them by surprise. People who are not Christians can be so deceived by false prophets that they never receive the truth. While it is the case that God wants us to be saved, it is also the case that God allows man free-will (John 3:16; 1 Tim. 2:4; 2 Pet. 3:9; Jos. 24:15; Rev. 22:17). That free-will can be exercised in such a way that causes one to be deceived by false prophets or even to become a false prophet.

Such false prophets may deceive individuals into thinking a form of "Christianity" different from what God actually established is an acceptable form but Jesus show us this is not the case. Jesus describes individuals who had done many good works in the name of the Lord, and yet they had not respected God's authoritative commands. Such individuals will not be saved. People can use religious terms, behave in a religious fashion, and even worship in such ways that will cause them to be lost. Going about with a lifestyle and vocabulary that appears to be very "Christian" while failing to actually know and obey what God commands is spiritually fatal. To such, the Lord will say, "I never knew you (Mat. 7:21).

The parable given in the context of this discussion teaches the necessity of both hearing and obeying Jesus. We don't want to hear false prophets who will take us away from Jesus by teaching false doctrines that excuse a failure to obey Jesus. Jesus is the One who must be heard,

and He is the One who must be obeyed (Mat. 7:22-29). Jesus is the Divine Son of God, and the One who has all authority (Mat. 28:18); Acts 2:36; Col. 1:14-18). We must hear Him, and the way we hear Him is by going to the New Covenant that was given to us by Him (John 14:16; Heb. 1). His Word is the standard we must teach and the rule by which we must live. False prophets may seek to deceive us into believing otherwise, but the fact is that Jesus is the judge (Acts 17:30) and His word is the standard of judgment (John 12:48).

Romans 16:17-18 shows us division is one of the problems caused by false prophets. Those holding to the truth are sanding firmly upon God's authority and the foundation for true unity. Division occurs when individuals depart from God's standard. If unity is truly understood to be precious, then false teaching should be considered a major problem because it is the false doctrine that causes division. False teachers should be marked and avoided for the divisions they cause. They are like a cancer in the church that continues to contaminate and consume. False doctrine destroys the health of a church as it takes churches away from sound or healthy doctrine. For this reason we must be determined to engage in spiritual surgery and cut out the problem. We do that by marking and avoiding those who trouble the church through lying doctrine.

As Paul speaks of false teachers in Romans 16 he indicates selfishness as a motivation for preaching error. These teachers do not serve Jesus. If they served Jesus they would teach the truth. But, because they are selfish, they have turned away from the truth for the sake of personal gain. Some turn to false teaching in order to take advantage of the church financially, or in order to gain power and influence. These self-glorifying false prophets are often very capable in deceiving others. The context here speaks of their ability to deceive with smooth words and flattering speech.

To his day here are many false teachers who seek to pull people away from the truth through smooth words and flattering speech. To be able to defend ourselves against the evil of false teaching we are going to have to know the Bible well. The Bible is God's standard of authority and the standard by which we shall be judged. We must not allow people to take us away from the truth. Beware of false prophets.
