GREAT CONFLICT AND STARK CONTRAST

The great spiritual conflict is the described in different ways in the Bible. It is the battle of the spiritually armored Christian against the cunning devil (Ephesians 6:10-18). It is the steadfast resistance of the Christian to the roaring lion who walks about looking for someone to devour (1 Peter 5:8-9). It is all the conflict between the spirit and the flesh (Galatians 5:16-26).

The works of the flesh are listed as adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery, hatred, contentions, jealousies, outburst of wrath, selfish ambitions, dissensions, heresies, envy, murders, drunkenness, revelries and such like (Galatians 5:19-21). Those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God (Galatians 5:21). This list shows a darkness and a self-imposed depravity that comes upon people who give themselves over to the flesh. But perhaps one of the darkest aspects to the works of the flesh is that not only do they hurt the one who engages in them, but they are such behaviors as can hurt others as well. As such the works of the flesh are harmful to society. When a nation gives itself over to the works of the flesh it will digress toward less and less civility the great spiritual battle we face is that of the Spirit verses the flesh. Let us fight to walk according to the Spirit and to push away from the works of the flesh for our own good, for the good of those we love, for the good of those around us, and for the good of our society, culture and nation.

Now the stark contrast. The fruit of the Spirit is listed as love, joy, peace, long-suffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Galatians 5:22-23). This list shows a brightness glory, and light that can transform individuals and lift up nations. The fruit of the spirit is such that not only will it have a positive effect upon the person bearing these characteristics, but it will help all of those they know and love. Additionally, it is this kind of behavior and character that shines a positive, wonderful, and glowing light upon every situation in life. These are noble and high qualities. These are perfect and pure influences. These are the fruit we see in the lives of those who walk according to the Spirit.

This great conflict and stark contrast is discussed again in Colossians chapter three. Those attitudes and actions that must be put to death in our lives include fornication uncleanness, passion, evil desire, covetousness, anger, wrath, manic, blasphemy, filthy language and lying (Colossians 3:5-9). The contrasted attitudes and actions that are seen in the lives of those who have set their minds on things above include tender mercy, kindness, humility, meekness, long-suffering, forgiveness, and love. When these character traits are seen in us we will find the peace of God ruling in our hearts, and the word of God dwelling richly within us (Colossians 3:12-17).

There is a great conflict in our world between good and evil. There is a great conflict within individuals between giving themselves over to the Spirit, or giving themselves over to the flesh. The conflict is a spiritual one that will affect the eternal destiny of souls. The contrast between the character traits of those who give into the darkness of the lusts of the flesh verses those who peacefully lift and brighten society by the fruit of the Spirit is clear. Clear enough that one does not have to think too hard to realize which way is the better way.
