WHAT DID WE LEARN?

Over the past few weeks we have looked at some of the valuable lessons taught by Jesus Christ while He was on this earth. We focused primarily on the book of Matthew in this study, and here is what we learned?

The sermon from Matthew 5:1-16 focused on two points:

1. To be happy in this life we need to have the qualities listed in Matthew 5:1-12. Those include humility, meekness, mercy, purity, peacemaking, and the willingness to endure persecution.
2. To be happy in this life we must recognize our purpose is to bring glory to God (Matthew 5:13-16).

The sermon from Matthew 5:17-48 focused on two points:

1. To be truly happy our faith must be genuine and sincere (Matthew 5:17-20). We learned that we must not excuse sin, and we must not be hypocrites like the Pharisees.
2. To be truly happy we must follow a higher moral standard, (Matthew 5:21-48). This includes the way we treat a brother, a spouse, and even an enemy.

The sermon from Matthew six brought us the following points:

1. To be happy our faith must be one of deep conviction, and not one that is marred by the superficial efforts to draw the praise of men for our own glory (Matthew 6:1-18).

2. To be happy our trust must be in God (Matthew 6:19-34). When our focus is on the spiritual and not the material we will be happier. When our trust is in God and not in wealth we will be happier. When we trust in God we will not need to worry about having the necessities of life.

The sermon from Matthew chapter seven showed us that to be happy one must:

1. Follow the golden rule (Matthew 7:1-12).
2. Follow the narrow way (Matthew 7:13-27)

From Matthew sixteen we learned two simple lessons:

1. Don't follow men (Matthew 16:1-12).
2. Follow Christ (Matthew 16:13-28).

From Matthew eighteen we learned:

1. Children are important (1-10).
2. The lost are important (11-14).
3. Your brother is important (15-35).

All the principles learned from these chapters in Matthew will help us to be more content, more peaceful, more hopeful, and more joyful. All of the words we studied came from the infinite wisdom of the Divine Son of God. Therefore their value is far above material wealth, and their power is far above the grandest of any of the works of man.
