TRUE WORSHIP

GOSPEL PREACHING

Last week we noticed, briefly, how the New Testament church had preaching as a part of their worship. (Acts 20:7) If the church today is to follow their example it must have in its worship the right kind of preaching. In determining what we shall preach it will be necessary to study the church presented in the New Testament and find what they preached.

Jesus Christ told His Apostles to "Go ye into all the world, and PREACH THE GOSPEL to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned." (Mk. 16:15-16). "And said unto them, Thus it is written, and thus it behooved Christ to suffer, and to rise from the dead the third day: and that REPENTANCE AND REMISSION OF SINS SHOULD BE PREACHED IN HIS NAME among all nations, beginning at Jerusalem." (Luke 24:46-47).

When the church at Jerusalem was scattered abroad, "they that were scattered abroad went everywhere PREACHING THE WORD. Then Philip went down to the city of Samaria, and PREACHED CHRIST unto them." (Acts 8:4-5)

"But when they believed Philip PREACHING THE THINGS CONCERNING THE KINGDOM OF GOD AND THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST, they were baptized both men and women." (Acts 8:12)

The Apostles at Jerusalem sent Peter and John to visit Philip in Samaria, "And they when they had testified and PREACHED THE WORD OF THE LORD, returned to Jerusalem, and PREACHED THE GOSPEL in many villages of the

Samaritans." (Acts 8:25).

When Philip met the Eunuch on the road that led from Jerusalem to Gaze and found him reading from Isaih, "Then Philip opened his mouth, and began at the same scripture and PREACHED UNTO HIM JESUS". (Acts 8:35)

In Corinth, "Paul was pressed in the spirit, and TESTIFIED TO THE JEWS THAT JESUS WAS CHRIST." (Acts 18:5)

Then the New Testament preachers preached The Gospel, Repentance and remission of sins in Christ's name, The Word, Christ, The things concerning the kingdom of God and the name of Jesus Christ, The Word of the Lord, Jesus, That Jesus was the Christ, Jesus Christ and Him crucified.

May we today be as true to the Great Commission as were these Gospel Preachers.
