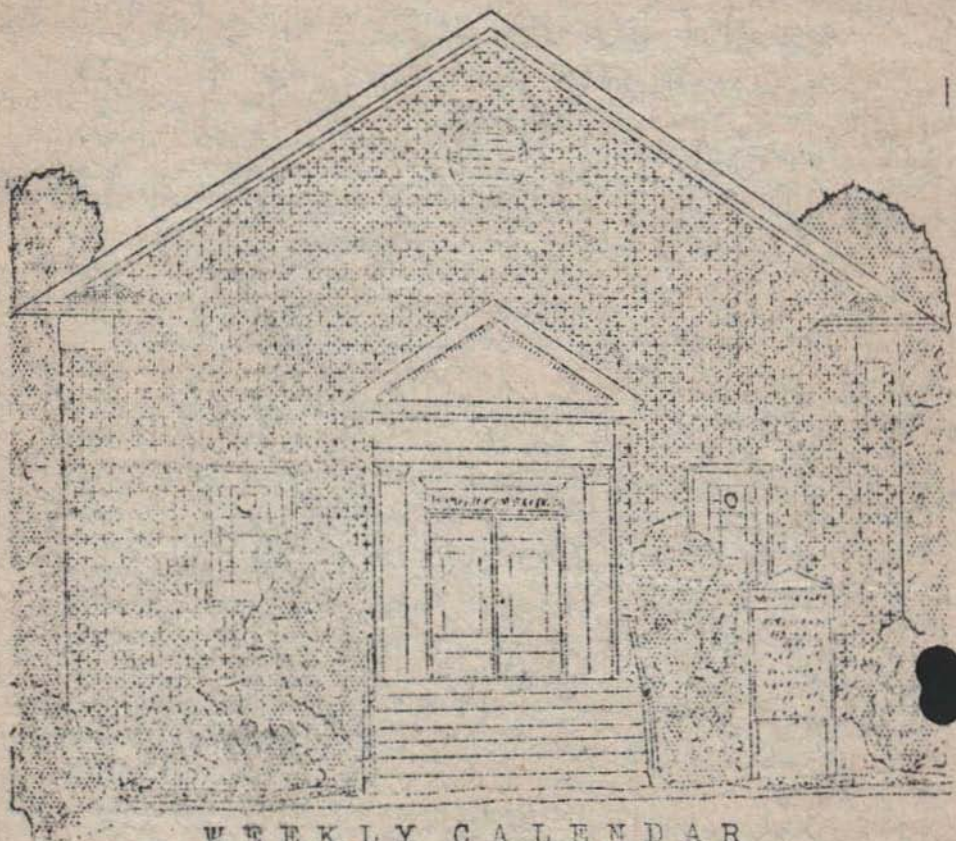

TRUE WORSHIP

SINGING WITH THE SPIRIT AND UNDERSTANDING

"I will sing with the spirit, and I will sing with the understanding also." (I Cor. 14:15). Here Paul was correcting their misuse of the spiritual gift of speaking in unknown tongues, or unknown languages. In the public assemblies some were praying and singing in language the others could not understand. Hence they were not benefited. Paul said, "I thank my God I speak with tongues more than ye all: Yet in the church I had rather speak five words with my understanding, that by my voice I might teach others also, than ten thousand words in an unknown tongue." (I Corinthians 14:18-19).

We should strive to understand what we sing. We should never merely repeat words and have no understanding of what we are singing. Many of our songs deserve far more careful thought and meditation than we give to them. To carelessly pass over these wonderful songs is to deprive ourselves of much spiritual food and hence are benefited very little from our song services.

If we do not understand what we sing can we expect those who hear to understand? If they do not understand we fail in one of the purposes of singing; that of teaching and admonishing one another.

We should also sing with the spirit, bringing the thoughts and feelings into harmony with the sentiment sung. This can be accomplished by being filled with the Spirit, or

by the word of Christ dwelling in us richly. To fail to sing with the spirit is to fail in the second purpose of singing; that of singing and making melody in our hearts to the Lord.
