The Father’s Responsibility

In today’s world, Fathers are needed more than ever. But why? When God made the home in Genesis 2, He made each role with a specific task to make the home what it needs to be. When those roles are not present and being fulfilled, then that home has certain problems and voids that would otherwise not be there if each role was present and doing its part. This is especially true when it comes to being a father in the home. The father plays a very important part in the structure and stability of the home. Today, I want to take a look at the primary responsibilities of the father.

First of all, the father **is to lead**. Whether we want to admit it or not, fathers are the head of the home (Eph. 5:23). With this being the case, we are responsible to lead our homes the way that God wants them to be. To lead, we must be an example (Matt. 5:16, Eph. 6:4, 1 Pet. 5:3). We all have our responsibilities. How are we doing as the head of our homes?

Secondly, the father **is to provide**. We are to provide the spiritual, physical, and emotional needs of the home. To provide the spiritual needs, we have to study and know the Word of God (2 Tim. 2:15) to bring our children up in the nurture and admonition of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Remember, we cannot lead our families to God if we don’t know the directions first. We are to provide the physical needs of the family (1 Tim. 5:8). We are also to provide the emotional needs of our family. Our family must be able to feel the love, support, and attention that they need. How are we doing as the provider of our homes?

Thirdly, the father **is to protect his family**. Since the father is the head of the home (Eph. 5:23), we are called to protect our family. We are the ones that are called to defend our home from threats and dangers both physical and spiritual. I believe it is easy for us to understand the physical role of physically protecting our families, but sometimes we forget that there is a deeper responsibility to protect our family spiritually. We will be the ones that will be held responsible for the outcome of our home and this should sober us. Are we allowing threats into our homes that will ultimately lead our family to Hell or are we doing what we can to prevent Hell as our outcome?

May we rise to the call that God has given to us as fathers to be the fathers that make our home what God intended for it to be!

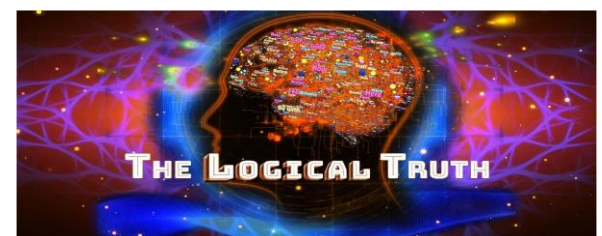
