The Righteous Judgment of God
Ezekiel 33:12-20

- I. Words to Understand
 - A. Righteousness
 - B. Wicked
 - C. Iniquity
 - D. Turns
 - E. Lawful
 - F. Remember
- II. Examination of Text
 - A. A man’s righteousness will not save A man who turns to transgression (12-13, 18)
 - B. A man’s wickedness, if he turns to righteousness, will live (14-16, 19)
 - C. Man’s judgment and thoughts will not matter on their judgment (17, 20)
- III. Application
 - A. If we are guilty of living in sin, having not turned to righteousness in obedience, we have hope.
 - 1. Jn. 1:12, Jn. 8:31-32, 1 Jn. 2:2
 - B. If we have turned back to wickedness, having once obeyed, we will die and have no hope until we turn back.
 - 1. Rom. 2:5-11, 2 Thess. 1:7-9
 - C. If there is sin that we are willingly committing, that sin will be the determining factor of life and death
 - 1. 1 Jn. 5:16-17
 - D. God’s judgment is SURE and cannot be changed
 - 1. Eccl. 12:13-14, 2 Cor. 5:10, Rom. 2:11
- Conclusion
 - 1. Is there sin in our lives that we need to deal with?
 - 2. Are we certain that if we were to stand before God today, that we would pass that test?
 - 3. There were those who thought they were ready, but they were not (Amos 5:18). Have we deceived ourselves?
