○○○RESURRECTION○○○

We have three basic reasons for believing that Christ was resurrected. First, we are told by the gospel writers that he was raised from the grave. Secondly, there was the empty tomb. There was a huge rock placed in front of the entrance and a guard placed there. The enemies of Christ did this because they didn't want any of Christ's followers to steal his body and claim that he was raised from the dead. After the third day the enemies of Christ found that the boulder had been moved and the body of Christ was gone. We know that the angel of God removed the boulder while the guard slept. Third, we have the appearances of Christ after his resurrection. He appeared to Mary after she had been to his grave, afterwards, found his body gone and was crying. He appeared to the eleven on the mountain and told them to "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature." After he had spoken to them he ascended into Heaven and sat on the right hand of God and there he reigns today. — Ray Moore —
