Know ye not your own selves, how that Christ is in you, except ye be reprobates? This is the "NEW NAME" spoken of in, Isaiah 62:2. And the gentiles shall see thy righteousness, and all kings thy glory: and thou shalt be called by a new name, which the mouth of the Lord shall name. We find, immediately after the conversion of Cornelius and his household, that this new name was given. Acts, 11:26. This we are sure is inevitable. And this is what Paul almost persuaded king Agrippa to be. Acts 26:28. Further, it is the NAME in which we glorify God. 1st. Peter 4:16.
