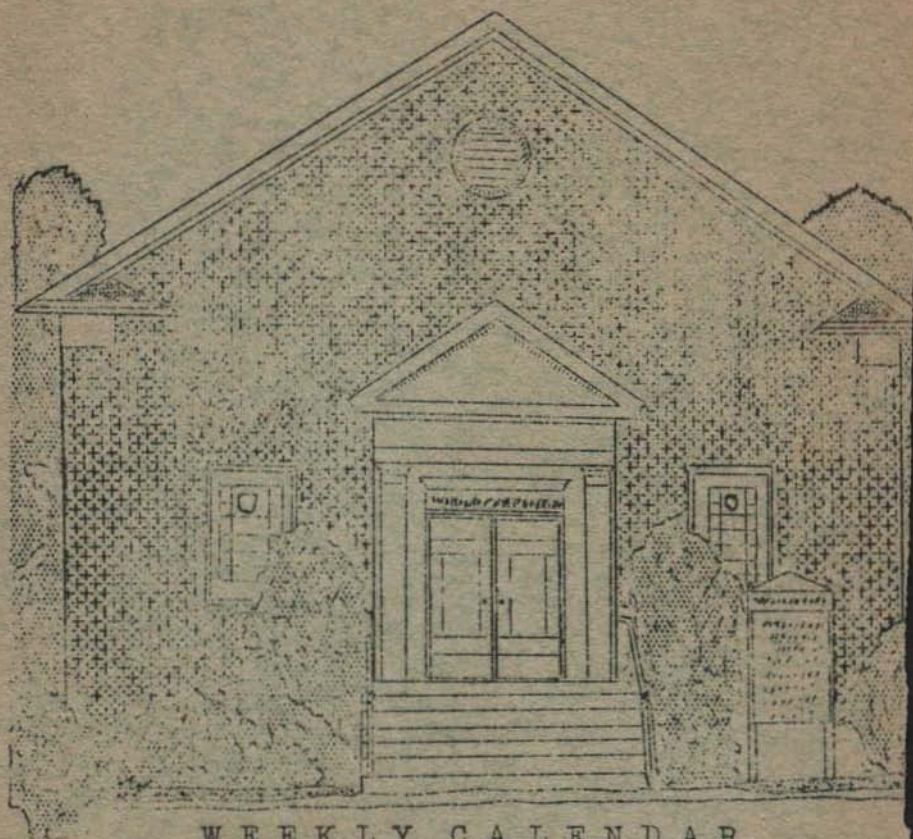

GOD'S ABILITY TO SAVE

Last week some scriptures were presented showing man's need of salvation. Men will not seek a Savior until they realize their need of salvation. If we believe God's Word concerning man's condition out of Christ we know that man needs salvation from sin. The wages of sin is death. If we believe this we will cry out in the words of Paul, "O wretched man that I am! Who shall deliver me from the body of this death?" *Romans 7:24*

Jude 24, Now unto Him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy.

James 1:21, Wherefore lay apart all filthiness and superfluity of naughtiness, and receive with meekness the engrafted word, which is able to save your souls.

Acts 20:32, And now, brethren, I commend you to God, and to the word of His grace, which is able to build you up and to give you an inheritance among all them which are sanctified.

II Tim. 1:12, ...for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that He is able to keep that which I have committed unto Him against that day.

Oh that we had the faith of the Hebrews and like them say, "If it be so, our God whom we serve is able to deliver us." But to just know we need salvation and that God is able to save, without the assurance that God is willing to save will not give us any hope.
