SANCTITY OF MARRIAGE

It is important that we know as much as we can about what God's says about marriage and the home. And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God."
- 2) Revelation 21:8: "But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death."
- 3) 1 Corinthians 6:18: "Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body."

Results of Your Efforts II Timothy 2:2

Last Sunday as we heard Mark Simons speak to us there should be thankfulness in each of our hearts for having the opportunity to help train gospel preachers. Warners elders many years ago saw the need for trained gospel preachers and this congregation helped several of them to attend school and prepare to preach. Mark and his brother Mike are two examples of faithful preachers whom we have had a small part in training.

In 2007 when the "North Carolina School of Biblical Studies" began, this congregation welcomed the opportunity to provide the funds to operate the school. Many of you provided additional funding for students. Since the school started, 8 men have graduated. These men are now preaching full or part time in different areas of the country. We pray that many more will be trained here in the coming years.

Another place we have had the opportunity to help train preachers is in Zambia. Since 1988 when Jack Simons introduced this congregation to Jerry and Edith Sullins, Warners has helped this work of training preachers at the "Zambia School of Biblical Studies". Since it began, the school has graduated 160 preachers. Over 80% of these men are still faithful.

One of the reasons the work in Nicaragua is so successful is because when we go there and establish a congregation, a trained preacher is assigned to work with that congregation.

These are just some of the works that you are part of through your contributions and your love for the Lord. There are many other works that you are a part of here at Warners, but none more far reaching than training preachers. This is one way we can help to fulfill the Great Commission.
