The Mouth Speaks From The Heart

Matthew 12:33-37 (NKJV) —33 “Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or else make the tree bad and its fruit bad, for a tree is known by its fruit. **34** Brood of vipers! How can you, being evil, speak good things? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. **35** A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good things, and an evil man out of the evil treasure brings forth evil things. **36** But I say to you that for every idle word men may speak, they will give account of it in the day of judgment. **37** For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.”

Did you know that the words that come from our lips, whether intentional or not intentional, are a glimpse into the heart of an individual? When the words are harsh and not edifying, then we see that the heart is cold and not good. But when we see that the words are kind, edifying, and loving, then we see that the heart is warm and good. The words are truly a product of the heart’s condition.

In our text, Jesus makes very clear and vivid statements that need to be evaluated and put into our minds. He begins by talking about how a person will be known by what things they produce. It is the case that WE are in control of our tree because He states “Either make the tree good or bad.” The fact is that if we want to have our fruit to bear good fruit, we have to make the effort to change our hearts to be good hearts. And the same, whether we want it to be or not, go for the other. If we never put the effort to focus on the good, our hearts will never be good and as a result, our words will never be good. But notice what He says in verse 34, “For out of abundance

of the heart the mouth speaks.” This means that the things that the are said from our mouths are coming from what is in the deepest parts of our hearts. The heart is the bank that is harboring all things and the outlet is the mouth. If we are noticing that we are bitter, jealous, angry, prideful, etc. it will be seen in the words in which we speak. But if we are good, faithful, loving, etc. in our hearts, it will be seen in the words that we speak. The real gravity of this text is found in verses 36-37 because it is the case that EVERY IDLE WORD will be brought up on the day of Judgment. **Can you imagine that EVERY WORD that we speak will be the determining factor of our justification?!** It really should cause us to reevaluate the way that we talk to others and what we say to others. We have got to make sure that we control our hearts so that the things that we produce will be that which is godly and not ungodly.

Ask yourself these questions:

How have you been talking lately: good or bad?
Are your words encouraging or discouraging to others?
Are our words uplifting or downgrading?
The content that we are speaking: is it godly or ungodly?
Are your words showing a good heart or an evil heart?

We are in control of the words that we speak and the condition that our hearts are in.

Do we have good control over our hearts?
