“Two Percent Will Destroy”

One time I had trouble with mice. So I bought some D-Con. I noticed on the package that only two percent of its contents was actually poison and the rest was edible. Now if some educated mouse could read, he might reason: “But there is so much good in it, a little bit won’t harm me, and besides I’m hungry.” Yet all that good food didn’t do that poor creature much good because the little bit of poison either killed him or gave him some mighty nasty indigestion. The ninety-eight percent nourishment was useless if that two percent killed him! The ninety-eight percent was not enough to offset the two percent.

The makers of D-Con know they have to put much good tasting food in before mice will be tempted to eat that little bit that kills them. This is parallel with the situation we find often in religion. Many feel that if there is so much good in their doctrines, a little bit of error won’t hurt them. But the devil is smart enough to give people enough of the truth to make his lies appear wholesome, but just enough error to condemn. No one will benefit from ninety-eight percent truth if there is two percent error mixed in with it. Man won’t go ninety-eight percent to heaven and two percent to hell: he’ll go to either one place or the other. Did not James say, “For whosoever shall keep the whole law, and yet offend in one point, he is guilty of all” (James 2:10)? The person who rejects two percent of the truth of God is guilty, just like the person who rejects all. The wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23).
