RIGHT AND WRONG

Think about your answers to the following questions. How would you answer each one.

• Which of is better: Coke or Pepsi?

Who is funnier: Donald Duck or Daffy Duck?

• Who is the better singer: Adele or Pink?

• Which is more fun: White-water Rafting or Zip Lining?

• Which fruit is tastier: Apple or Orange?

So, which answers were right? The truth is these questions are a matter of personal taste and preference. The answers are neither right nor wrong. These are Subjective questions. Concepts that are subjective may not have a right or wrong answer. On the other hand, Objective concepts have a right or wrong answer when applying an objective standard.

For example, when measuring ingredients for a recipe, one should be careful to use proper measuring tools that are objective in nature. Manufacturers design and fabricate a measuring cup that holds 8 ounces of liquid. They must be precise. For a recipe to be effective one must have a measuring cup that is the same as one made by another manufacturer so that objective standards can be met so there is no guess-work involved.

This is how we must view the authority of the Scriptures. They are an objective standard. God clearly tells us in His word things that are right and things that are wrong. Some decisions are left up to us. Jesus tells us to "go into all the world" but does not limit us in the method we choose in "going."

The important thing is that we respect the authority of His objective standard of truth.
