Which Is The Greatest Commandment?

Jesus was asked, "Which is the first commandment of all" (Mk. 12:28). He answered in a way that summed up the entirety of the Law of Moses. We read, "Jesus answered him, "The first of all the commandments is: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one. And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these" (Mk. 12:29-31). In answering this, he summarized the entirety of the 10 commandments. The first 4 commandments were for man's relationship with God and are summed up as they were to love the Lord with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength. The last 6 of the 10 commandments were for man's relationship with man and are summed up as they were to love their neighbor as themselves. The beauty of this is that Jesus brought about a summary of the eternal laws that God expects out of His creation. I know we don't follow the 10 commandments, as per Moses, today, but these principles of loving God with everything we have and loving our neighbors as ourselves still apply. The specific details of the law may have changed, but 9 out of the 10 laws have been instructed in our New Testament (excluding the Sabbath). So the question that we need to ask ourselves is "Are we loving God with everything we have and are we loving our neighbor as ourselves?" If not, God expects it! He always has and He always will!
