# SALVATION (Part 4)

The concept of Baptism has been the subject of controversy for hundreds of years. The denominational world does not believe that it is necessary for salvation. The Methodist Discipline states that "Baptism is not only sign of profession and mark of difference whereby Christians are distinguished from others that are not baptized; but it is also a sign of regeneration or the new birth." (Methodist Discipline, 1962). They say that it is a line of demarcation BETWEEN Christians. However, the Bible says that Baptism is a line of demarcation between those in the world and those in Christ (cf. 2 Corinthians 5:17).

Nowhere in their publications do they mention that Baptism removes sin. Acts 2:38 says Baptism remits sin. Revelation 1:5 says that Jesus "washed us from our sins in his own blood." Saul was told to "be baptized, and wash away thy sins" (Acts 22:16). When Paul reminded the church at Rome [Romans 6:3-4] of their baptism, he reminded them that they arose from that "burial" to walk in newness of life!

Mark 16:16 ["He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved"] is a simple passage. It is analogous to the explicit instructions of a Doctor to a patient. "If you take medicine A and medicine B you will recover. This implies that if you fail to take medicine A or medicine B you will not recover. If we fail to do all the will of the Father then we will fail to recover.

# **Elders Corner:**

## DO WE LOVE THE LORD MORE?

"So when they had dined, Jesus saith to Simon Peter, son of Jonas, lovest thou me more than these? He saith unto him, Yea, Lord; thou knowest that I love thee. He saith unto him, Feed my lambs" (John 21:15).

**Do We Love the Lord More Than Our Kinsmen?** If we do, we will not let them keep us from obeying the gospel. We will be willing to leave the religion they have accepted if it is proven wrong. We will not let them keep us from attending the services of the Lord's church. Remember Jesus said, "He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me" (Matthew 10:37).

**Do We Love the Lord More Than Money?** If we do, we will not make the heaping of riches the chief object of our living. We will give liberally of our means to the Lord (2 Corinthians 8:1-5). Remember, the Lord said, "For the love of money is the root of all evil" (I Timothy 6:10).

**Do We Love the Lord More Than Pleasure?** If we do, we will not engage in that which is forbidden, that which will hurt our influence for Christ. Remember, the Lord, in speaking of perilous times, said men shall be "lovers of pleasures more than lovers of God" (2 Timothy 3:1-4).

**Do we Love the Lord More Than Praise of Men?** If we do, we will be willing to stand for the Lord and the right, though we must stand alone (2 Timothy 4:16-17). The chief rulers "did not confess him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue: For they loved the praise of men more than the praise of God" (John 12:42-43).

The Lord should be the supreme object of our affection (Matthew 22:37). May we learn to sing, and mean it, "More love to thee, O Christ, more love to Thee!".
