THESE THINGS

Peter wrote, "he who lacks these things is shortsighted (2 Peter 1:9)." Concerning the same thing Peter said, "If you do these things you will never stumble" (2 Peter 1:10).

What are "these things" that Peter is talking about? They are those things that you must give all diligence to add to your faith (2 Peter 1:5). They are those things that enable you to be fruitful in your service to God (2 Peter 1:8). They are those things in which you must abound (2 Peter 1:8).
