THE "HOLY SEE" OF ROME

You might not have ever heard this term but Catholics are very familiar with it. The term, "Holy See," refers to the government of the Roman Catholic Church. Ambassadors are not Vatican City ambassadors, but are Ambassadors to the Holy See.

The Holy See has a new leader or Bishop. He is also known as the Pope. Now I know that a new Pope is a big deal news-wise, but there seems to be an overwhelming attraction to this new Pope. Maybe it's because there are over a billion Catholics in the world. Maybe because the last Pope was the first Pope in 600 years to retire [the mode of succession is usually death]. Who knows?
