For any person to despise discussion must indicate at least one of these five things: (1) He does not understand what discussion is and what it intends to accomplish (that is ignorance of an innocent, but a hurtful, nature); or (2) he is mentally lazy and does not want to engage in a sustained thinking--does not want to weigh, analyze, and discriminate (this is satisfaction in ignorance, and, therefore, guilty ignorance); or (3) he sincerely thinks his views are right and he cannot endure to have them contradicted or even questioned (this is egotism, intolerance, and bigotry of the worst type); or (4) he is indifferent to the right or the wrong of the ~~xxxxxxx~~ question and does not care which side prevails (if it is a vital question, this is infidelity); or (5) he knows his views and practices are wrong and he does not want them exposed (this is downright dishonesty).--
