## **TOP TEN REASONS YOU ARE IMPORTANT**

### **1. God Loves you.**

"For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life (John 3:16). "In this is love, not that we loved God, but that he loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins" (1 John 4:10).

### **2. God wants you to be in heaven.**

"The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance" (2 Peter 3:9). "For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth" (1 Timothy 2:4).

### **3. God created you.**

"So God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him, male and female he created them" (Genesis 2:27). "And He has made from one blood every nation of men to dwell on all the face of the earth" (Acts 17:26).

### **4. God died for you.**

"By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren" (1 John 3:16). "For when we were still without strength, in due time Christ died for the ungodly" (Romans 5:6).

### **5. God wants you to have hope.**

"Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead" (1 Peter 1:3).

"For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance" (Romans 8:25.)

**6. God wants you to be in His family.**

“Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him” (1 John 3:1). “For both He who sanctifies and those who are being sanctified are all of one, for which reason He is not ashamed to call them brethren” (Hebrews 2:11).

**7. God gave you free-will.**

“Choose yourselves this day whom you will serve...But as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD” (Joshua 24:15). “In truth I perceive that God shows no partiality. But in every nation who ever fears Him and works righteousness is accepted by Him” (Acts 10:34-35).

**8. God wants you to love Him.**

“And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength. This is the first commandment” (Mark 12:30). “For this is the love of God, that we keep His commandments. And His commandments are not burdensome” (1 John 5:3).

**9. God wants you to worship Him.**

“But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him” (John 4:23). “And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as is the manner of some, but exhorting one another, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching (Hebrews 10:34-35).

**10. God gave you a priceless message.**

“For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ, for it is the power of God to salvation for everyone who believes, for the Jew first and also for the Greek” (Romans 1:16). “All Scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, thoroughly equipped for every good work” (2 Timothy 3:16-17).
