PREPARING FOR COMBAT

We can learn a great deal from watching animals in the wild. I remember watching Wild Kingdom on television when I was a boy. In one episode the producers were monitoring the development of the Alaskan Moose. Each year the moose would eat great amounts of food to help store nutrients for their bodies during the Winter. A secondary benefit of massive amounts of food was that it helped them develop greater antlers for the Spring. In the Spring the moose would begin a fighting contest that determined the "pecking" order in their respective foraging areas and their rights to court the females. Usually the moose with greater antlers and weight would be the victor of such combat.

So, what is the lesson for us? Spiritual battles are inevitable. As such, we must prepare ourselves for these battles. Each of us experiences spiritual attacks in the form of co-workers, friends and family who do not understand our drive to be knowledgeable of God's word which produces great faith. Whether or not we are the victor or victim depends not on our wits or skills, but on a superior knowledge of Scripture. What we do in advance of these combatic interludes will determine the outcome of these times. Now is the time to develop enduring faith, strength and wisdom. Now is the time for prayer, reading, studying and memorizing God's word. Then when combat is inevitable you will be prepared to overcome the Wicked One.
