Giving All Diligence

Last Sunday night we took a look at 2 Peter to discuss God's great and precious promises. We spoke of the promise in 2 Peter 1:10, "you will never stumble," and showed how this promise was conditional. That is, "if you do these things you shall never stumble." What things? The context is discussing giving all diligence to make sure that specific Christian characteristics are added to our faith (2 Peter 1:5-11). But, not just that they are added to our faith, but that they also abound (2 Peter 2 Peter 1:8).

The benefits to having the qualities under consideration in the text added to our faith include the fact that we will not be unfruitful in our work (2 Peter 1:8). Additionally we will never fall if we abound in these qualities (2 Peter 1:10), and further "an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ (2 Peter 1:11)." The benefits of adding these qualities to our faith are so great and so important that Peter tells us we must give all diligence to adding and abounding in them (2 Peter 1:5). Peter also shows the importance of this discussion by telling the Christians he is going to continue to remind of these things while he lives, and the leave them a written reminder when he passes on (2 Peter 1:12-15).

Clearly these qualities are extremely important. We did not have time last Sunday night to fully discuss each quality so take a look at definitions and descriptions below:

1. Virtue: This refers to excellence in moral goodness. It is the description of one who adheres to a high moral standard.

- 2. Knowledge: In the context, grace and peace are multiplied in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord (2 Peter 1:2), and all things that pertain to life and godliness have been given to us through the knowledge of Jesus (2 Peter 1:3).
- 3. Self-Control: This is a core characteristic that causes us to give diligence to adding these virtues to our faith, and which enables us to abound in them.
- 4. Perseverance: This is the idea of being steadfast, pushing forward, continuing to remain faithful in good and in difficult times, but especially with an emphasis on difficult times.
- 5. Godliness: Showing reverence and respect for God in the way one lives.
- 6. Brotherly Kindness: Loving our fellow Christians as siblings in the same family. God is our Father and fellow Christians are our brothers and sisters. We must love one another as such.
- 7. Love: The benevolent, good-will love that looks out for the best interests of others.

Let us first be sure to add all of the qualities to our faith. Once we know that we have added these qualities to our faith let us then work to build on them so that we excel and abound in them. Then, let us continue to try grow beyond that as we seek greater spiritual maturity, and as we continue to examine ourselves in the light of these characteristics. "For if you do these things you will never stumble (2 Peter 1:11)."
