THE PERSPECTIVE OF A PILGRIM

Growing up, basketball was something that was near and dear to me. Every single day, I looked forward to lacing up my shoes, grabbing a ball, and going out to shoot some hoops. I attended practice after practice, and game after game. But one thing that I always knew, was that if a game ever fell on a Sunday or a Wednesday, worshipping God our Father always came first. I was taught the ability to put the worldly things (like basketball, among other things as well) into perspective and understand what truly is the most important thing in this life, and for that, I am truly indebted to my parents. In order to meaning the perspective of a pilgrim, we must . . .

1). HATE - Hate? Hate?? Caleb, how could you ever say that we must hate ? We must love, should we not? Everything and everyone in society is telling us that we ought to love, and accept this and accept that, and not worry about what it is, just make sure we love it because love wins. How dare we hate anything . . . But does God hate? I read in Proverbs chapter 6, that God actually does more than hate the sins and transgressions of man; they are actually an abomination to Him. *“These six things the LORD hates, Yes, seven are an abomination to Him”* (Proverbs 6:16). I am reminded of what the Psalmist said, *“You who love the LORD, hate evil!”* (Psalm 97:10). We must hate the things that God hates.

2). LOVE - We love because God is love, *“Beloved, let us love one another, for love is of God; and everyone who loves is born of God and knows God. (8) He who does not love does not know God, for God is love”* (1 John 4:7-8). We love the souls around us because God loves them (1 John 4:19)

3). FOCUS - As an athlete, something that you must train your mind to do is focus. On game day, you block out all other distractions that are going on around you. As Christians, having a heavenly focus is so vital in being a faithful Christian. Paul said, *“...forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead”* (Philippians 3:13b). Paul is imploring that we focus on Heaven as our goal, and in doing so, we can be found faithful in the sight of God.
