6 Environmental Components

#2 - THE EXPRESSION OF APPRECIATION AND AFFECTION

Introduction

- Love is being so completely oriented to another - in thought, feeling, and behavior - that their best interests and desires become as important, if not more so, than your own.
- 1 Corinthians 13:4-8
- Romans 12:9-10
- Everyone is in need to feel like they belong! - (Eph. 1:4-6)
- Love, Appreciation, and Affection must be EXPRESSED! (Rom. 5:8, Jn. 3:16, 1 Jn. 3:18)
- Jesus DESIRES that we show appreciation (Lk. 17:11-19)
- EVERYONE LONGS TO BE VALUED!
- THE SELF-ESTEEM OF A PERSON WILL EITHER MAKE OR DESTROY A PERSON.
- The bucket and dipper illustration
 - "If someone puts you down, they've got their dipper in your bucket. By my estimate, it takes about 10 positive strokes to repair the damage of one negative."
- A CLOSE BOND develops among people who enjoy and appreciate each other's company.

**The 6 Steps Of Expressing
Appreciation And Affection**

1. Look for the GOOD in each other (Mk. 12:31)
2. Affirm your children VERBALLY
3. Expect children to be Affectionate and Appreciative (Rom. 12:10, Eph. 5:18-20, 1 Thes. 5:18)
4. Share Humor And Playfulness (Psalm 89:15, Prov. 15:13, 17:22)
5. Purposely encourage Affection and Appreciation (Prov. 31:28)
6. Accept Expressions And Appreciation Gracefully
