## **Looking At The Eldership?**

When one considers becoming an Elder one must look at all the qualifications that are found in the New Testament. There are many that jump right out at us [able to teach, husband of one wife, etc.] but there are a few that often go overlooked and that are just as essential for one to be qualified as an Elder.

Found in 1 Timothy 3:3, "covetous" is a term that is often overlooked. We are blessed to be a part of a congregation that has within its borders, men who are interested in writing books that will help us to understand God's Book. D.C. Mock's "Leadership That Works," offers several paragraphs toward this topic.

An elder is not to be "covetous" (1 Timothy 3:3). Covetousness is a plague on society. Covetousness is a terrible sin. It cuts to the very heart of the all loving, all giving, and all merciful God. "No covetous man or woman, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the Kingdom of God" (Ephesians 5:5). Can one be covetous and not realize it? When one gives fifteen dollars a week to the church treasury and could easily give thirty dollars without reducing one's standard of living, that one is being covetous. Yet if one would ask if they thought they were covetous, they would probably say "no." When one supplies their every want (instead of needs) and then forgets those in need or their obligation to give as prospered (1 Corinthians 16:1-2), that person is being covetous. Occasionally, abundance is spent on pleasurable and leisurely things, and very little is given to the church. Covetousness and greediness go hand in hand. An elder with this attitude cannot be a good leader and does not meet this qualification. [Emphasis mine, PEK](p. 22)

Since one who is covetous does not meet the qualification that prohibits this he cannot and should not seek the office of an elder. One who would do so is not honest with himself or with God. We trust the elders to administer the funds that are given on the first day of the week. How could we trust a covetous man?
