FOUR REASONS TO SERVE GOD

1. Serving God is the purpose for which we were created.

"Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is man's all. For God will bring every work into judgment, including every secret thing, whether good or evil" (Ecclesiastes 12:13-14).

2. Serving God produces tremendous qualities in our lives.

"But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control" (Galatians 5:22-23).

3. Serving God prepares us for eternal life.

"But God be thanked that though you were slaves of sin, yet you obeyed from the heart that form of doctrine to which you were delivered. And having been set free from sin, you became slaves of righteousness. . . For when you were slaves of sin, you were free in regard to righteousness. What fruit did you have then in the things of which you are now ashamed? For the end of those things is death. But now having been set free from sin, and having become slaves of God, you have your fruit to holiness, and the end, everlasting life. For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord" (Romans 6:17-23).

4. Serving God is a reasonable response.

"I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service" (Romans 12:1).

THREE REASONS TO BELIEVE THE BIBLE IS FROM GOD

1. The Bible's Amazing Production.

The first five books of the Bible were likely written somewhere around 1440 B.C. The last book of the Bible was likely written somewhere around A.D. 96. Therefore, the process of writing the Bible took between 1,500 and 1,600 years. The Bible was written by about forty men from different backgrounds, places, and time periods. In addition, it was written in different languages. Yet, despite all of this, the sixty-six books of the Bible all fit together as a remarkable unit. This is not possible without God guiding the process for those 1,500 to 1,600 years.

2. The Bible's Amazing Preservation.

No other ancient work can compare to the manner in which the Bible has been preserved. The Hebrews Old Testament has been preserved in the Septuagint, the Dead Sea Scrolls, and the Masoretic Text. The New Testament has been preserved through nearly 6,000 ancient Greek manuscripts, and other ancient language translations. There is nothing like it.

3. The Bible's Amazing Prophecy.

The Bible accurately prophecies of the beginning and end of nations. The Bible prophesied of kings who were yet to come, even specifically calling Cyrus by name before he was even born. The Bible contains approximately three hundred prophecies of the Messiah, all of which were fulfilled in Jesus of Nazareth. It would not be possible for all of these prophecies to come to pass without God behind the prophecies.
