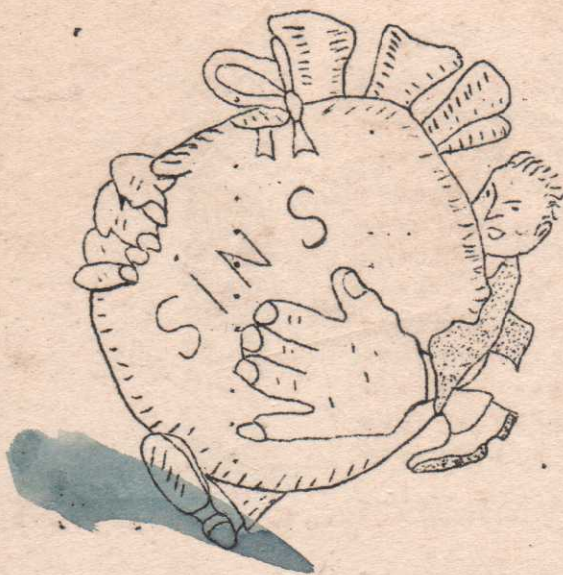


WARNERS CHAPEL MESSENGER

ARE YOU INDIFFERENT?

Neglect is based upon indifference. If one thinks he may get by with failing to comply with the requests of the Lord, he may allow himself to neglect his duty. The reason he is not impressed with the absolute need of obedience is that he is indifferent to the teaching of the word. Read the account of the letter to the church in Laodicea (Rev. 3:11-19). This church was afflicted with indifference. The message to it was that it should either repent and do the will of God wholeheartedly or cease claiming to be following the Lord. They were not acceptable in the indifferent state.

Think of your condition. Do you attend every meeting of the Church? This includes the mid-week assembly. Do you study your Bible every day? Do you pray often? What about your attitude? Are you indifferent? You cannot please the Lord if you are.
