The Attributes Of A Real Woman In The Home

- I. A wife should willingly subordinate herself to her husband, encouraging him to be the leader and guardian.
 - A. Man was made first (1 Tim. 2:13, 1 Cor. 11:8)
 - There is no question where God stands about what a woman's relationship tot B. heir husband is to be. (Eph. 5:22, 24, 33, Col. 3:18, Tit. 2:5, 1 Pet. 3:1, 5-6)
 - C. Just as He places upon the male and awesome, terribly responsible role as head (and will hold him accountable for his failure to discharge that role properly), Sunday AM Bible Study so He places the woman in a subordinate role and will hold her equally 10AM accountable.
 - D. We need to realize that when people fail to fulfill their God-given responsibilities, SIN RESULTS. (1 Tim. 2:14, Gen. 3:16)

II. A Wife Should Give Careful Attention To How She Dresses

- A. The Bible seems to go out of its way to stress to women (more than men) proper attire (1 Tim. 2:9-10, 1 Pet. 3:3-4)
- B. Since the outward beauty is fading, it is the case that she needs to focus more on the inner beauty, and put a greater emphasis on this, that includes attitude, spirit, and demeanor. (Prov. 31:30, 1 Tim. 2:9-10, Tit. 2:3-5, 1 Pet. 3:2-4)
- C. When this takes place, the wife becomes a model for a life that is fixed on the will of God.

III. A Wife Should Actively Promote The Well-Being Of Her Family

- A. NO WHERE in the Bible does it say that a woman must "stay at home".
- "Homemaker" (Titus 2:5) carries with it that she has a work pertaining to the B. home for which she is responsible.
- C. Whatever else she may do with her time, she must not neglect her domestic responsibilities (just as the man must not neglect his domestic responsibilities).
- D. Of all people who pass through her life, she should want her husband and children to make it to Heaven. Therefore, she will give her foremost attention to this goal.
- The virtuous woman is a a great description of the many activities of an E. effective wife. (Prov. 31:10-31)
- Whatever a woman thinks the world has to offer her by means of the corporate F. ladder and the business world, she will never find a more satisfying, fulfilling meaningful pursuit in life than servicing her family in preparation for eternity.

Conclusion: So as wives, are you being the real woman that God has called you to be, or the woman that society and culture is saying you need to be?
