
God's Remedy for Hydrophobia (Part 4)

The story is told in 2 Kings 5. Naaman was "captain of the host of the king of Syria... but he was a leper" (v. 1). Among the servants of his household was an Israelite maid who knew of God's work done through Elisha, and she got word to her master to go to Israel. But when Naaman arrived, Elisha did not do as Naaman expected (v. 11). Elisha just told Naaman to go and dip seven times in the Jordan, and he would be cleansed. But this made Naaman angry! He had better rivers at home (v. 11-12), and he left for Syria.

But Naaman had a servant who dared to say what needed to be said: "If the prophet had bid thee do some great thing, wouldst thou not have done it? How much rather, then, when he saith, Wash, and be clean?" (v. 13). When he heard that, Naaman decided to trust God. He dipped seven times in the Jordan, and when he came up the seventh time the leprosy was **gone** (v. 14). He was cleansed. By water.
