PRIORITIES IN THE HOME

8. We will not take our vacations so as to cause them to miss any school, but we have no qualms of conscience about taking our vacation during the time of the Vacation Bible School or the summer gospel meeting.

9. They see us go to work even though we do not feel too well, but stay at home from church services under the same circumstances?

10. They see us avidly look and study their school work, but never pay any attention to all the handwork brought home from their Bible classes?
