Nicaragua Mission - Year 18

Since 1998, Warners Chapel has participated in the annual Medical/Evangelism Campaign to Nicaragua. In less than 2 weeks (June 17th), 6 members and a guest from the Gold Hill Road church of Christ will be flying from Greensboro to Miami to Managua and then the following day onto Telica by bus to begin setting up the medical facilities.

The campaigners will be staying in León which is about 2 hours (by old, slow school bus) west of Managua. This area is much more isolated and accommodations are limited. This year only 80 campaigners were allowed to sign up due to the limited accommodations and those spots filled in less than two weeks. Due to the limitations there were no “matrimonial rooms” available. That’s the term used in Nicaragua for a double bed for married couples so there will only be all women and all men’s rooms available (most likely 3 or more per room). Apparently the hotel was able to add a few beds to some rooms and there will be a total of 88 campaigners.

All of the Warners participants have contributed their \$500 commitment fee, the treasury contributed \$500 per participant and the balance was funded this year from the Jim and Gladys Harper memorial. Money is always taken for various benevolent and special needs that arise such as purchasing additional rice and beans, medicine, clothing, wheelchairs or Bibles. For those of you who can’t go, this is an opportunity for you to participate in this good work. There are envelopes on the desk in the foyer marked Nicaragua if you would like to give over and above your regular contribution.

Our ladies have been making dresses for the past several months and it is always great to see how excited the little girls are when they receive a new dress.

This is an opportunity for the entire congregation to affect the lives of several thousand people both physically and spiritually. Please pray for the campaign, the safety of the participants and do whatever else you can to make it a success.
