DEEP ROOTS

Have you ever tried to pull weeds in your lawn or garden? As we get older, getting up and down becomes more difficult, but the weeds keep coming. One of the most prevalent weeds is the Dandelion. It is a very prolific and hardy weed. One of the reasons for this is that it has a very deep root system. Like the iceberg, a Dandelion's root system is twice as long as the plant above ground.

I find this very interesting. You see, the very same thing is true about us. What is not seen at first—what is not easy to see on the outside of us—is really the most important part of us. The most important part of us is our faith in God. That is our greatest strength and that strength is deep inside of us. It is our root. It is what gives us life and helps us to keep going whenever something bad or sad happens to us. It also helps us to know the right thing to do when we have to decide about something that is hard for us.

An Old Testament example that also portrays the advantage of having deep roots is found in Psalm 1:1-3, which says, "Blessed is the man who walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. But his delight is in the law of the Lord and in his law doth he meditate day and night. And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water that bringeth forth his fruit in due season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper."

Just like a Dandelion, we can be prolific and hardy if we develop deep roots.

REMEMBERING SEPTEMBER 11th

In the words of Alan Jackson, "Where were you when the world stopped turning?" September 11, 2001, a day not soon to be forgotten. Memorials have bee set up, terrorists have been terminated, a decade has passed and we still find ourselves concerned about the safety of our country because of those practicing Islam.
