Nicaragua—Part 2

There are always "Nicaragua Moments" and I want to share one of mine.

On Tuesday, my evangelism team studied with a man named Dermo. As the soul-saving gospel was taught, he was overcome with emotion, tears began to flow, and he expressed his desire to be baptized. His 13 year old daughter, Kayla, was listening in on our study. As we went to baptize him, she asked us to come back and study with her more. We did and she was baptized later that day. Around 5 pm. We went back and studied briefly with the mother who had been working all day. On Wednesday another team studied with the mother again and she was baptized. Three members of this family were baptized into Christ. I saw Kayla several more times before we left Nandaime and she always came ove and hugged me. Events like that lift our hearts and encourage us.

At the same time, our hearts ache seeing families living in conditions worse than what we might use for a barn or a pig lot under a tin roof with some plastic walls and dirt floors. Sadly, that's how 80% of the world lives. I know that the 15 of us left Nicaragua recognizing just how truly blessed we are.

A few months ago I arranged with Allen Womack for Domingo (the local coordinator) to take me to Tierra Prometida (Promised Land) and meet with Juan Carranza, whom Warners Chapel supports. I took Dana along with Andy and Mindy. We met with Juan for a bit and chatted with him about the work. The work is going well. They had 3 baptisms the prior week during VBS (some of the campaigners went for two weeks) and 1 restoration.

Juan told me to share with the congregation his thanks for your support and prayers. He has had his share of challenges to overcome with the congregation but things are greatly improved. The building has been painted a bright color, he has a new podium to preach from, and the place looked very nice.

Thanks again for your continued support of the Nicaraguan mission work. Keep our 20 new brothers and sisters in Christ in your prayers.

In the cemetery beside the Cane Ridge church house near Paris, KY, is a stone which marks the grave of brother William Rogers. The marker has these words on it: "Born in Campbell County, Virginia, July 7, 1784. Moved to Cane Ridge, Bourbon Country, April, 1798. United with the church of Christ at Cane Ridge in 1807."
