RECAP

Last week's lesson on Marriage, Divorce, and Remarriage [MDR] was an inoculation. Remember, an inoculation is a way to inject a substance into the body that will eventually prevent one from contracting a disease. For years, some of our brethren have had the desire to mix and fellowship those in religious denominations. There has been an unofficial agenda to accomplish this effort, but think about ways that this could be accomplished. The following might be some steps in this direction.

- 1) The commencement of interdenominational meetings to discuss differences. [These unity meetings began in the late 70's and early 80's between the church and the Christian Church]
- 2) Promoting the idea that we must agree on the seven "ones" of Ephesians Four while disregarding other matters that are matters of indifference [so-called] like instrumental music, Holy Spirit, etc. [Rubel Shelley's "Core Doctrine."]
- 3) The support of the MDR concept that alien sinners are not subject to God's law of marriage. This would enable us to accept into fellowship those who were in adulterous marriages [Bales, Evans, SR.]. This problem is rampant in America.
- 4) Baptism is not essential to salvation [Max Lucado, et.al.], therefore we can fellowship anyone who "has a relationship with Jesus."

These and others are examples of a hidden agenda to broaden the kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ by compromising the truth. We should always be vigilant when we hear "strange things" and new "adjustments" to God's word.
