DELIVERANCE

I think that Bible students would do well to ponder the theme of God’s deliverance more seriously. In Exodus 3:8 God told Moses *“I have come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up from that land to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the place of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perezites and Hivites and the Jebusites.”* Think for a moment about what lessons we can learn about God from this verse.

1). God delivers those who cannot deliver themselves—The Israelites were slaves in Egypt and the Scripture says that they, *“groaned because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry came up to God because of bondage”* (Exodus 2:23). Every person who desires deliverance from God must first acknowledge the inability to deliver oneself. Jesus said that those who are poor in spirit, people who admit they cannot deliver themselves, are blessed and will inherit the kingdom of heaven (Matthew 5:3).

2). God delivers people from slavery - Exodus 3:8 speaks of God delivering the people “out of the hand of the Egyptians.” Under Egyptian slavery, the taskmasters were harsh (Exodus 1:11), and human life was definitely not seen as precious (Exodus 1:22). God rescued them out of their bondage, and He still rescues people today. Scripture teaches that we are slaves to sin (John 8:34; Romans 6:16), but that God provides deliverance from that darkness (Colossians 1:13). God is in the business of setting captives free.

3). God delivers people to something much better - Not only does God break the chains of slavery, but He also blesses abundantly: “[I will] *bring them up to a good and large land, to a land flowing with milk and honey . . .*” When a person becomes a Christian, he is blessed “with every spiritual blessing in heavenly places in Christ” (Ephesians 1:3). God does not deliver people from bondage merely to leave them alone, but He promises His abiding presence, strength, guidance, and love (Hebrews 13:5; Ephesians 3:16; John 17:17; Romans 5:8). He always brings people to something much better than they had before.

4). God delivers people according to His plan - notice that Exodus 3:8 specifies which land God was going to give to His people (The Canaanites, Hittites, etc.). Those who wish to accept God’s deliverance must also accept His plan. The Israelites did not possess the right to dictate to God where they would settle —that right belonged to God alone. Neither is it the case that Christians have the right to alter God’s plan and design for delivering people today (cf. Revelation 22:19; Deuteronomy 4:2). God has designed the best plan to deliver His people. The God of heaven knows what is best for us and wants desperately to deliver us from the bondage of sin. Will you accept His deliverance in your life?
