## THE GOSPEL ADVOCATE

The Gospel Advocate began 158 years ago by Tolbert Fanning and William Lipscomb. Fanning began preaching at the age of 19 and began traveling with Alexander Campbell from 1835ff. He and his wife Charlotte created a school for Christian young ladies. In 1845 he established Franklin College. Men like David Lipscomb, P.S. Fall, E.G. Sewell and T.B Larimore. P.S. Fall was the brother of Fanning's wife, Charlotte. Fall was converted to the Church by Fanning and consequently converted the entire Congregation of Baptists where he preached and this was the first Church of Christ in Nashville.

William Lipscomb was the older brother of David Lipscomb. About the middle of the year 1855 T. Fanning and W. Lipscomb began the publication of the Gospel Advocate as a monthly, and continued it until the Civil War opened up when they were compelled to suspend the publication. His writing in that paper was of a conservative, practical, and devotional character, seldom taking active part in the controversies that came up during the continuation of that paper. But he never forgot to urge and impress his lifelong theme of practical religion. It would, indeed, be hard to express in adequate terms the good he did through that paper during its publication along this line.

The Gospel Advocate is still influencing others for good and continues its commitment to truth and opposing error.
