"SAME-SEX MARRIAGE WILL NOT HURT OR BOTHER ANYONE"

There is a pervasive lie that has been told for years that Gay [Same-Sex] marriage does not affect anyone else. As far as I am concerned this is just another form of sin that exists in the world. Though, now legal in the U.S., this does not change the fact that God condemns it. But does Same-Sex marriage affect anyone else but those who participate in it? We did not actually need to nationalize gay marriage to realize this. We have had examples for years from the states that already legalized the practice. Combined with the growing public hostility towards supporters of traditional marriage, it is impossible at this point to deny that Same-Sex marriage is growing and a serious threat to liberty of those who disagree with it.

Remember Gresham, Oregon, a state in which Same-Sex marriage has been legal since 2014. In Gresham, a couple of bakers declined to make a <u>wedding cake for a lesbian wedding</u>. Because the lesbians in question endured "emotional and mental suffering" after their cake request was turned down, the state's labor commissioner demanded that the bakers — a husband-and-wife team — pay the plaintiffs \$135,000. In addition to this astronomical charge, the commissioner <u>ordered</u> that the couple was not allowed to publicly proclaim their desire to not bake cakes for Same-Sex weddings. That is to say, the state slapped the Christian bakers with an enormous fine, then silenced them from advocating the point of view for which they were fined.

How far away are we from churches losing their tax exempt status if they oppose Same-Sex marriage? Although Justice Kennedy has said, "that religious organizations and persons [will be] given proper protection," he is not the only Justice on the Supreme Court Bench.

Mark Oppenheimer, [a beliefs editor for the New York Times] has said, "Now's the time," he announced after the [Supreme Court] ruling, "to end tax exemptions for religious institutions." (Internet, June 28, 2015)

Time and time again, it was repeated: if Same-Sex marriage is legalized, it will have nothing to do with you. Well, here we are. Same-Sex marriage is legal. And it is clear that it will have everything to do with every one of us. We were lied to, and we will have to deal with the consequences, one silenced bakery and one non-exempt church at a time.

I want to take this opportunity to thank you for your support throughout the years. Many exciting things are happening relating to the work as it started in Botswana in 1988. We now have 174 graduates from the school in Botswana/Zambia School of Biblical Studies. The East Africa School of Biblical Studies in Uganda, East Africa has now graduated 42 men in four classes and the 5th class of seven students has now begun it's second year of studies in a new facility outside of Busia, Uganda.

We left for Zambia on June 23rd and were there for a month at ZSOBS. During that time I was able to teach the present class of 16 students who had just begun their second year of studies. Also, during the time, we held our bi-annual Seminar and 54 past students came and spent 4 days with us. At the Seminar we were able to enjoy a Lectureship, reports from those who attended and had many sessions where we discussed issues that pertained to their works. It was a wonderful time of fellowship. Noted was the maturity in those who attended. Our plans and dreams have been fulfilled over and over again as we see the continued growth of the students. I look forward to bringing you a further report of the Seminar and the present class in an upcoming Newsletter.

A side note is that out of our efforts that began in Uganda in 1988 not only are there now three schools in operation in Zambia, Uganda, East Africa and Ghana, West Africa but there are several local schools of preaching located in Zambia, Tanzania, Kenya and soon to be in Malawi. The Kansas Expressway church of Christ actually sponsors the school in Zambia. The other two schools are mostly supported by other sponsors. I have been asked to supervise the school in Uganda and my son Ray supervises the school in Ghana.

Thank you so much for your love and support and for considering our work in your upcoming Missions Day. Our work is only limited by the support we receive.

Please remember my wife Edith in your prayers. While with me in Zambia and Uganda, she suffered from some serious physical issues. After we got back on August 6th, we made an appointment to see her doctor the next Monday. We were told to go to the ER for tests. After four days of hospitalized tests she received open heart surgery to replace her aortic valve. She is in Rehab and may be there for another two weeks. God has truly blessed us by keeping her until we could get back to the states and get the medical services she needs. Please remember her in prayers. We love you all.
