WHAT DO I LACK?

"And, behold, one came and said unto him, Good Master, what good thing shall I do, that I may have eternal life? And he said unto him, Why callest thou me good? *there is none good but one, that is, God*: but if thou wilt enter into life, keep the commandments. He saith unto him, Which? Jesus said, Thou shalt do no murder, Thou shalt not commit adultery, Thou shalt not steal, Thou shalt not bear false witness, Honour thy father and *thy* mother: and, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. The young man saith unto him, All these things have I kept from my youth up: what lack I yet? Jesus said unto him, If thou wilt be perfect, go *and* sell that thou hast, and give to the poor, and thou shalt have treasure in heaven: and come *and* follow me. But when the young man heard that saying, he went away sorrowful: for he had great possessions."

In Matthew 19:16-22, a young man came to Jesus with a great question. Most young people never begin to think about eternal life. Jesus' instruction to him were things that the Old Testament required of the Jews in order to be faithful to God. But the young man protested that he had done all these things. He had been dutiful to the Law of Moses. So Jesus, knowing his heart, gave him instruction to go and sell all that he possessed and give it to the poor.

In every age there have been those who will do all what God wants them to do as long as it does not cause them discomfort. Brethren will come Sunday morning for worship, [many times skipping Bible study] and not come Sunday night or Wednesday night. At those times there are great opportunities to learn about God and His will for us. It is hard to understand how a Christian can ignore such blessings.

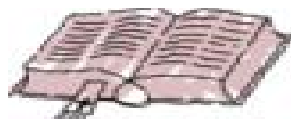
