INDEPENDENCE DAY

John Adams said, "that these United Colonies are, and of right ought to be, free and independent States. The 2nd of July, will be the most memorable epoch in the history of America. I am apt to believe that it will be celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival. It ought to be commemorated as the day of deliverance, by solemn acts of devotion to Almighty God. It ought to be solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations, from one end of this continent to the other, from this time forth forevermore."

Though Adams spoke of a date relevant to the adoption of the document, July 4th was the signing date of the Declaration of Independence. It is that date that we recognize as the date that declared that we are no longer under the rule of a foreign ruler.

There seems to be a great parallel comparing the freedom that was gained be revolting from the tyranny of George III, King of England and how Christ has made us free from the bondage of sin and death. Romans 8:2, says, "For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death." The Christian's freedom comes as a result of a debt paid by the Son of God. When we answer the Gospel call through our submission to His will and are baptized, that day becomes our Independence Day. We are independent of the law of sin and death. The irony is that, by the same act, we pledge our spiritual loyalty to another: Jesus.
